## **Ambassadors**



## AusID Global App

All of our students will participate in the new and exciting AusID App. AusID GLOBAL is a uniquely

Australian approach to personality profiling that is fun, effective and easy to apply. Students complete an online app, consisting of a series of questions which have no right or wrong answers, to profile the individual. Once completed, the student will be matched with one of four Australian animals which becomes their totem.

Learning about the characteristics of their totem assists the student to have a greater awareness and understanding of themselves in relation to work, life and learning. It assists students and their teachers to understand the individual's values and deeper needs when considering future study options or choice of career. Most importantly, it teaches students its ok to BELIEVE in themselves and have a positive SELF AWARENESS. Students are provided with an introduction to their personality type.
